

BOARD MEETING MINUTES

ROSSFORD PARKS & RECREATION COMMITTEE (FOR 3/13/17)

I. Meeting called to order at 6:00PM.

- The board discussed the silver sneaker contract Ordinance 2017 – 18. By approving the contract the rec center would become a Silver Sneaker facility and any Silver Sneaker member would be able to utilize the facility for free. The Rec Center would be reimbursed by Tivity Healthcare \$2.50 per person/visit up to \$20 per person/month.
- Mr. Ledesma updated the board on Beech Street Park, where a light pole was knocked over during the wind storm. Also, the recreation department is looking to purchase a new scoreboard. The city is currently working on filing an insurance claim for the light pole. Mr. Wagner wanted the department to look into sponsorships for a new scoreboard to help offset the cost.
- The Spring Egg Hunt is scheduled for April 15 at 11:00AM, and all Rossford kids up to 4th grade are allowed to participate. Letters have been sent to businesses asking for baskets to raffle away to the kids.
- Mr. Ledesma updated the board on some projects slated to start later this year. They included: New rooftop units, Rec Center gutter, Vets Court Tennis Court Project, and Plumbing for the locker room showers.
- Mr. Ledesma had a meeting with the Toledo Botanical Gardens about the possibility of a Community Garden. They recommended that we submit soil samples, and look for a viable water source. The Toledo Botanical Gardens will help with some grant options for community gardens.
- Ms. Owen updated the board on upcoming programs including: Spring Break Camp, Travel Basketball, Spring Soccer, Flag Football, and Summer ball.
