

BOARD MEETING MINUTES

ROSSFORD PARKS & RECREATION COMMITTEE (FOR 6/11/18)

I. Meeting called to order at 6:00 PM.

- The Summer Theater program will be producing the show “Aladdin Junior” this year. Katelyn Walker has been selected as the director and the show date is August 3 at 7PM at the Rossford Methodist Church
- The board discussed the possibility of having liquor licenses available for gym rentals. Mr. Ledesma has been in touch with liquor permit attorneys and is reviewing the recreation center policies already in place. The board brought up to check on if this qualifies as the entertainment district and location near the Methodist Church as this may affect the ability to get the permits.
- Mr. Ledesma updated the board on some capital improvement projects and quotes that have come in for those projects. These projects include:
 - Painting the outside and inside of the building
 - A new ladder for gym roof access
- The parks and recreation department are working with the CVB to convert the Beech Street Tennis courts into pickleball courts. They are currently researching and applying for funding for this project.
- The Parks and Recreation Department will be putting up a levy renewal in May 2019 or November 2019. The board discussed changing the language of the levy so that it can include maintenance projects and bondable items at the parks.
- Summer day camp is in full swing and they have 44 kids registered which is the largest group to ever be enrolled.
- Mr. Ledesma updated the board on the upcoming events held in the city which include:
 - Chautauqua
 - Glass City Balloon Race
 - Riverfest
