



# Public Safety Committee

Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, February 27 2018

The fire Department presented an update on the investigation into the upgrade to 24 hour staffed coverage. This would be a 3 person model, 24-hour coverage with part time employees. The committee recognized the urgent situation with department staffing and discussed moving ahead. Mrs. Karen Freeman was at the meeting. She and Chief Drouard met and are putting together a list of all costs associated with 24 hour staffed coverage. Mrs. Freeman said that they needed about a month to try and pull this information together and populate it. One major challenge of the 24 staffed coverage is the need for living quarters And a meeting/classroom. The committee discussed the timing of information to put a levy on the ballot. Mrs. Freeman informed us that we have a few months before we have to start filing paperwork. *^ Ahead*

The committee went on to discuss speed cameras. Mr. Oberdorf requested a preliminary protocol for use of the cameras. Chief Goss will work on putting this together. The committee agreed to discuss the pros and cons further.

Ms. Zuchowski-Eckel asked Chief Goss for an update on the program to keep trucks off of residential streets. He will check with Mr. Scott And Mr. Kolb to get an update on the signage.
