Meeting Minutes

February 27, 2015

Attendance: Caroline Zuchowski-Eckel, Robert Ruse, Ed Ciecka, Tyler Kolb and Robert Williams (MSG).

The committee met in conjunction with the bi-monthly update from Robert Williams of MSG.

1. Mr. Williams updated the Committee on the current projects with MSG.
2. The committee then discussed back in angled parking. Resident reviews have not been positive. It seems dangerous and creates a traffic jam. Perhaps in the future when more cars are equipped with back up cameras it will be a better solution, but at this time the committee feels it'll be more disruptive to the community than beneficial. Council has previously requested that MSG study back in parking on Route 65 in the business district. At this time the committee recommends that the direction of that study be changed to concentrate on additional parking options in the down town business district, with the exception of back in angled parking .
3. Mr. Williams provided the committee with construction standards to review and mark-up.
