

Public Work's Meeting Minutes

June 27, 2016

1. Equipment needs - The 1993 sweeper is down, valued at \$7500, it will cost between \$30,000 and \$62,000 to rebuild. Mr. Kolb and Mr. Igo have found a 2009, similar to what we have, that is being refurbished for \$95,000. A new one will cost in the area of \$185,000. Mr. Ruse would like to explore sharing one. Mr. Scott will contact Northwood and Perrysburg Township to see if there is any interest. The committee would like this item to go to Finance tonight so that we can move ahead on this. There is currently a Bobcat down and a Backhoe down. Mr. Igo would like to see an equipment committee formed to keep track of all of the equipment condition, age and replacement schedule city wide. The committee agreed that this was a good idea.
2. Hiring Process – Mike Logan was hired after the last civil service test. A new test will be offered and advertised better to find the second hire.
3. Reconstruction of West Elm Tree – The committee conferenced called in Tom Stalter from NWSD to discuss the plans for the improvements as paper copies were not supplied to the city at the time of the meeting. They will mill down 6" then examine the base. There is terrible drainage midway down the street on the Northside and they will do their best to correct this issue. Due to the damage to the street NWSD will be replacing the entire width of asphalt. The committee discussed making the street a no parking street. The committee also discussed adding sidewalks. Mr. Scott will follow up on this for the next meeting.
4. Updates from Mike Scott - Mr. Scott updated the committee on the status of the Colony Road Pump Station Abandonment Project, Downtown Parking study, Lime City Bridge Project, Crossroads Pond, Storm Water Coalition through the Wood County Engineers office, the Urban Paving Project, and the Crossroads Paving Project.
