SR 65 Urban Paving – project update

- Schedule – on schedule – substantial completion ~mid-Sept; final Oct 1st
- Curbing issues – still below total dollars
- Shelt Property and School Road Work – 2019
- School drive lane replacement of City decorative lights – no update
- Eagle Pt to Lime City drive widths – everyone has been contacted
- We need to determine stripping of parking lanes yet.

IPS Crosswalk and other Downtown crossing locations:

IPS, maple, Walnut, High School/Moes – ODOT safety dollars being reviewed. On hold as part of SR 65 project. – MSG reviewing potential dollars

Tree Lawn Parking:

Per Comm of the Whole – review on case by case bases as the streets are upgraded – no feedback from Safety Comm yet

Colony Association:

NWWSD Waterline update – MSG underway – NWWSD only wants to do what is in pavement Bidding/construction is scheduled for 2019 Karen is reviewing bond utilization.

Colony Road (Hillside to gate) – assessment project but MSG is reviewing OPW’s grant funding

Eagle Point Road (West end - Colony to Cemetery) – coordinate project with NWWSD Sanitary project – Tom Salter was proposing this as early as 2019 but will plan on it going in 2020

Lime City SR 795 Interchange & OTC Overpass: Nothing new, keep on agenda

Storm Water Utility update:

Planning on 1/1/19 implementation. MSG is working with Administration on several steps to get us there.

Signalization Project – black pole concerns – MSG proposed to paint in accordance with ASTM standards and give five-year warranty. Bob Motioned/Jerry 2nd to recommend MSG paint and then repaint in 7 yrs. Motion passed. B Williams going to discuss with management.

LED Street Light conversion – Administration still reviewing with Edison

Micro-paving schedule– MSG provided ideas, committee will review further maintenance ideas

SR65/Colony/Lime City Roundabout – Bob wanted to make sure we were communication with adjoining properties. Tetra Tech will talk with property owners with questions and West Erie Realty will initiate ROW discussions shortly

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City alleyways – Jerry raised concerns over the ice cream shops use of the alley – who owns it, can they park in it, is the temporary fence sections allowed, and is the BBQ grill allowed? Committee wants to forward this to administration/zoning to review

Vineyard/Gross Waterline and Paving – due to no/limited subbase (stone) under the pavement, pavement and storm sewer options are being evaluated by Poggemyer Design group – Tom Stalter to make sure that MSG and PDG discuss status so we minimize the delay of reconstruction.
