

# Public Work's Meeting Minutes

September 6, 2016

1. The committee met with representatives from NWSO to discuss the Colony Road Pump Station Abandonment Project restoration and paving. The pump station has been torn down and they were in the process of bringing in top soil. NWSO presented us with a diagram of what curbs would be replaced as part of the project. Mike Scott is to contact MSG as they were asked to give us a recommendation on what additional curb should be added for proper drainage.
2. NWSO representatives agreed to go over to Elm Street and look at the depressions in the road where all of the service laterals were cut in.
3. Road repair to West Elm Tree -  
Sidewalk costs – Mike Scott to get an <sup>AERIAL</sup> of the area to mark up. Mike asks that the committee members walk the area to look at the issues first hand.  
  
No Parking – Public Works committee recommends no parking on West Elm Tree in order to preserve the new roadway. The committee would like the Safety committee to review the issue for safety concerns.
4. Construction Standards – The committee is pulling together additional information on the construction standards and will meet in one month to finalize these.
5. Limiting truck traffic – Mike Scott will sit down with Chief Goss to review the progress on this item.
6. Equipment Needs – The committee asks that Mr. Kolb put together and provide to them an equipment inventory including logs of repairs and costs of repairs.
7. Civil Service Test Update – the test was given and has been certified. Backgrounds checks are currently being done.
