

# Public Works Committee Meeting

## Minutes

### November 21, 2016

Attendance -- Robert Williams -- MSG, Andy Langenderfer Tetra Tech, Ms. Zuchowski-Eckel, Mr. Ruse, Mr. Oberdorf, Mr. Kolb, Mrs. Freeman and Mr. Scott,

- Tetra Tech came in to discuss the State Route 65 Paving Project, phases 1 and 2. The discussion centered around how to handle areas of curbing and sidewalk that will need to be replaced. Mr. Langenderfer provided preliminary costs for these different areas. The committee asked that Tetra Tech do a full survey on the area between Bacon and Bergin Streets. Mr. Scott and Mr. Kolb are going to walk some of the other areas and take some measurements. The committee also discussed the Intersection project at SR 65 and Lime City Road.
- Mrs. Freeman and Mr. Scott presented a few financing ideas for how to get the SR 65 Urban paving. They will be presenting these ideas to the Finance committee on Monday the 28<sup>th</sup>. The Public Works Committee is asking for the Finance to Committee to look into options and cuts that can open up monies to use as our matching funds.
- Mr. Scott updated the Committee on
  - the downtown signalization project which is on track,
  - The Pilkington RR Crossing which we would like to have completed in conjunction with the SR 65 Urban paving project
  - The Bike path, which remains stagnant at this time.
- Mr. Kolb informed the committee of the issues with the Leaf Truck and that the frequent breakdowns are significantly slowing down leaf collection
- The committee asked that Mr. Williams pull together the Storm Water utility information that MSG has compiled. The committee would like this to be available and discussed before the end of the year.
