1. The City of Rossford will receive sealed bids for the Rossford Safety Study Improvements 2021 PID 112132 at the City of Rossford Municipal Building, 133 Osborn Street, Rossford, Ohio 43460, until **3:00 p.m., local time, Monday, February 1, 2021**. The work consists of the construction of Crosswalks, Pedestrian Ramps, bump out, sign and sign supports, guardrail replacement and pavement markings and work associated with these improvements.
2. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the City of Rossford Municipal Building, 133 Osborn Street, Rossford, Ohio 43460, immediately upon closing of the receipt of bids.
3. Bidders must submit a **standard bid** based on a completion date of **July 16, 2021**. The lowest and best bid will be the awarded the contract, the Engineer's Estimate of most probable cost for the project is **\$182,099.50**.
4. Bidding Documents will be available after **10:00 a.m. on Monday January 4, 2021**. A pre bid meeting will be held at the Rossford Municipal building on **Wednesday, January 20, 2021 at 1:00pm**.
5. Bidding Documents may be obtained at the City of Rossford Municipal Building, 133 Osborn Street, Rossford, Ohio 43460, or The Mannik & Smith Group, Inc., 1800 Indian Wood Circle, Maumee, Ohio 43537.
6. Bid security in the form of a Bid Bond in an amount equal to 10% of the contract total bid sum, and payable to the City of Rossford will be required of all Bidders.
7. Performance Bond and Payment Bond, equal to the amount of the Contract, will be required of the bidder awarded the Contract

8. Bidders must comply with the regulatory and licensing requirements of the State of Ohio.
9. Bidders must comply with ODOT's LPA Template (ODOT Spec Book and LPA Spec Book) Required Contract Provisions.
10. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after the opening of bids.
11. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, select any or all projects, and to waive any informality or irregularity in any bid.
12. The Contractor affirmatively represents to the local contracting authority that it is not subject to a finding for recovery under Ohio Revised Code §9.24, or that it has taken the appropriate remedial steps required under §9.24 or otherwise qualifies under that section. The Contractor agrees that if this representation is deemed to be false, the contract shall be void and initio as between the parties to this contract, and any funds paid by the state hereunder shall be immediately repaid to the local contracting authority, or an action for recovery may be immediately commenced by the local government and/or for recovery of said funds.
13. The Contractor must secure and maintain valid Ohio workers' compensation coverage until the project has been finally accepted by the local contracting authority. A certificate of coverage evidencing valid workers' compensation coverage must be submitted to the local contracting authority before the contract is executed.

The failure to maintain valid workers' compensation coverage shall be considered a breach of contract which may result in the Contractor or subcontractor being removed from the project, withholding of pay and/or termination of the contract.
14. In accordance with Ohio Revised Code §153.03 and during the life of this project, the Contractor and all its Subcontractors that provide labor on the Project site must be enrolled in and remain in good standing in the Ohio Bureau of Worker's Compensation ("OBWC") Drug-Free Workplace Program ("DFWP") or a comparable program approved by the OBWC.
15. In accordance with Ohio Revised Code §164.05 (A)(6), to the extent practicable, the Contractor and subcontractor shall use Ohio products, materials, services and labor in connection with this project.
16. Contractor agrees that it is currently in compliance and will continue to adhere to the requirements of Ohio Ethics law as provided by Section 102.03 and 102.04 of the Ohio Revised Code.
