

Public Works Committee Minutes
Thursday, July 15, 2021, 11:00 am

Called to order: 11:01 am

1. 2022 Street Projects/ Jennings Rd –

- a. Had preliminary discussion on next steps
- b. Waiting for survey data to confirm ROW
- c. Will evaluate design based on parking/traffic flow, capital cost, water quality and operating cost
- d. General discussion that “one size doesn’t fit all” – i.e., curbs are not always the answer
- e. Mayor commented on no assessments, contrary to recent practices.

2. Watershed Protection Program –

- a. Todd shared an update on meeting with Wood Co Eng’s office on the City creating a watershed protection plan
- b. The plan will strengthen the City’s position to secure grant funding

3. Glenwood/SR 65 Intersection –

- a. Tetra Tech and Todd/Admin. reviewed the traffic study/light timing
- b. A simple fix, is not always possible – new traffic loop in pavement can’t be combined with traffic sensor – we cannot mix the technology without a major update to the signalization controller box
- c. Todd/Tetra Tech looked at reasonable short-term solutions of enhancing traffic flow
 - i. Three similar options of adding a right turn lane using the City owned parcel to the east
 - ii. RSR added a fourth option- if we could secure property/ROW from the school, we could try to create a T-intersection for safer vehicular and pedestrian traffic flow – Tetra Tech to evaluate and if it looks possible, the Mayor would reach out to school for property
 - iii. Long term solution, a round-a-bout

4. Street Light/LED Conversion Update –

- a. City owned lights in the parks – Allyson/Tyler have inventoried and are in contact with Edison; there is also a street light at the intersection of Lime City and the school athletic complex.
- b. Colony – lights are being installed currently
- c. Design on additional decorative lights from Eagle Point Rd to Lime City – Allyson to discuss with Tetra Tech

5. Wales Rd Maintenance Facility –

- a. Site clean up planned due to storm water compliance issues
- b. Want to plan for the future
- c. Site walk planned for Sept.

6. Parking Standards – on hold
