- 1. New Plow Truck**
 - a. Public Works wants to replace a '90's plow truck that is not functioning
 - b. \$161,073.95 is State Bid price
 - c. \$90,000 already appropriated in '21's budget
 - d. Jerry motioned/2nd Bob – order truck with funding from '21 and '22's budget – truck will not be available until next winter season
- 2. 2022 Street Projects/ Jennings Rd –**
 - a. Survey / ROW data in
 - b. Tetra Tech/Todd reviewing options
 - c. Parking Standards will be reviewed as part of Jennings design
- 3. Pavement Maintenance/Inventory Program –**
 - a. Inventory by MSG is complete
 - b. GIS inventory system getting started
 - c. We will need to purchase more equipment
 - d. Todd will share more at future meeting
- 4. Hawthorne**
 - a. Starting Sept. 13th
 - b. About 3 wk. construction
- 5. Glenwood/SR 65 Intersection –**
 - a. Tetra Tech and Todd/Admin. reviewed the traffic study/light timing
 - b. Sensor was adjusted
 - c. In the queue for future TMACOG funding for dedicated right turn lane
- 6. Safety Project –**
 - a. Final directional signage going in any day for Eagle Point/SR 65
- 7. New Items**
 - a. **Hannum Sewer** – Todd will verify is NWWSD is going to have to replace the sewer where dozens of patches have been cut in the road (in newly paved road)
 - b. **Storm Water Repairs** – recent storms resulted in a collapse of 12" sewer in alley behind Rec Center and Methodist Church and along blockage in 12/9" line on Schreier Rd
 - c. **Schreier Rd Gas Line** – 4,000' of line being installed – extremely deep to get under the bridge – test pits will be backfilled with controlled density fill to ensure pits don't settle
