

BOARD MEETING MINUTES

ROSSFORD PARKS & RECREATION COMMITTEE (FOR 11/8/21)

I. Meeting called to order at 6:00 PM.

- Fall Sports
 - Little League football 5/6 grade team finished 5th at the OAC state tournament to end their season.
 - U8 girls' soccer team won the league tournament at the end of their season. This is the first soccer championship for the Rec soccer program.
- Winter Sports
 - Little pups' basketball registration ended and the program started the second week in November.
 - There are over 120 kids registered. (56 in 2020, and 65 in 2019)
- Student Representative
 - Maci Bihn has been selected as the next student representative for the parks and recreation committee. Maci is a junior at Rossford High School
- Alumni Reunion Event
 - The recreation center is in talks to host a decade class reunion on November 25, 2022. Mr. Ledesma has been in talks with the hosts and Kevin Heban to get any necessary paperwork submitted.
 - This would be a big event and they will be looking to obtain a liquor permit for the event.
- 2022 Capital Improvement Projects
 - The parks and recreation department are targeting 2 projects that will be taking place in 2022. A restroom/concession stand at Veterans park and fixing the EIFS at the recreation center.
- Beautification Committee Presentation
 - Cherie Hall from the Rossford Beautification updated the board on some projects that they would like to work on next year.
 - They would like to put some flower beds at Veterans Park around the veteran's memorial at the top of the park. They are looking to apply for some grants with the help of Julie Jardine for these projects.
 - One issue that they are trying to work on is water, and are hoping for city help to accommodate these flowers, and others that they would like to see around town.
 - Mr. Staczek recommended that they also work with the parks, facilities, marina committee.
