

BOARD MEETING MINUTES

ROSSFORD PARKS & RECREATION COMMITTEE (FOR 4/13/20)

I. Meeting called to order at 6:00 PM.

- 2020 COVID Update
 - All playgrounds are shut down and have had caution tape put around them
 - All basketball rims were removed at all parks
 - Swings were removed at all parks
 - The Recreation Center has been closed since 3/13
 - The meals of wheels senior lunch program are still operating out of the building
 - All programs have been suspended or cancelled at this time.
- Social Distancing Programs
 - The recreation center has had a number of programs for the community that fall in line with social distancing measures
 - Coloring contest – participants were able to pick up a packet of coloring pages to color at home and turn back in. All participants were given a gift card which was donated by Dogg's Ice Cream
 - Egg Hunt – The recreation center held an Egg Hunt scavenger hunt where participants had to find 15 different colored eggs. The Rec put some at the local businesses and encouraged residents to decorate their yards as well. 5 kids who turned in completed forms were randomly picked to win a prize
 - The Recreation Department is looking at doing a few more programs similar to these to keep the community engaged during this time.
- Building Improvements
 - LED Lights – The recreation center was able to complete the transition to LED lights for all lights within and around the facility. They also replaced all Exit signs in the building
 - Gym Floor Maintenance – Every 3 years the gym floor at the Recreation Center is sanded and stained in the summer. We were able to get this project completed during the time we were closed. It requires the gym to be closed for 1 week.
