

BOARD MEETING MINUTES

ROSSFORD PARKS & RECREATION COMMITTEE (FOR 11/14/16)

In Attendance: Toby Ledesma, Dan Wagner, Lizzy Hornyak, Dan Wilburn, Larry Oberdorf, Caroline Zuchowski-Eckel

I. Meeting called to order at 6:00PM

- The Fall Soccer season had its end of year tournament and all 3 boys soccer teams made it to the finals.
- The youth basketball programs have begun and participants are up across the board. Little pup's basketball has over 65 participants, and Mavericks basketball now has its largest numbers in the history of the program.
- Mr. Ledesma recapped the Haunted Trail that was held over Halloween weekend at Island View Park. There were over 250 people that came to experience this event. The RHS Drama Club made \$141 in donations.
- The Rossford Recreation Department will be holding its annual Rudolph Run 5K again this December 17th. There will be a 1K kids run that starts at 8:30am and the 5K race will begin at 9:00am. Participants can register at the Recreation Center, or online at IMathlete.com. Links to both registration forms can be found on the Rossford Rec Center's website under special events.
- The board discussed raising prices for facility rentals.
 - Mr. Ledesma said that room rentals have not been raised for at least 20 years, and he was not able to find any information on any changes to these prices. Councilman Wagner added that the prices were the same when he rented the rooms for a baby shower over 20 years ago. The prices currently are \$60 per room or \$110 for both. This is for a 4 hour block. Councilman Oberdorf said that \$100 per room and \$150 for both would be fair in his opinion, especially since the renter has use of the kitchen and all of its appliances. The rest of the board agreed on this price.
 - The other facility being considered would be the rental of the baseball fields. Mr. Ledesma stated that with growing numbers in the rec baseball program, field space is becoming extremely valuable. In 2016 the rec baseball program had 19 teams to schedule. The current price for this facility is \$35 per game or \$50 for a double header. Mr. Ledesma felt that raising prices to \$50 per game and \$75 for a double header would be a good start for pricing. The board agreed on this price.
